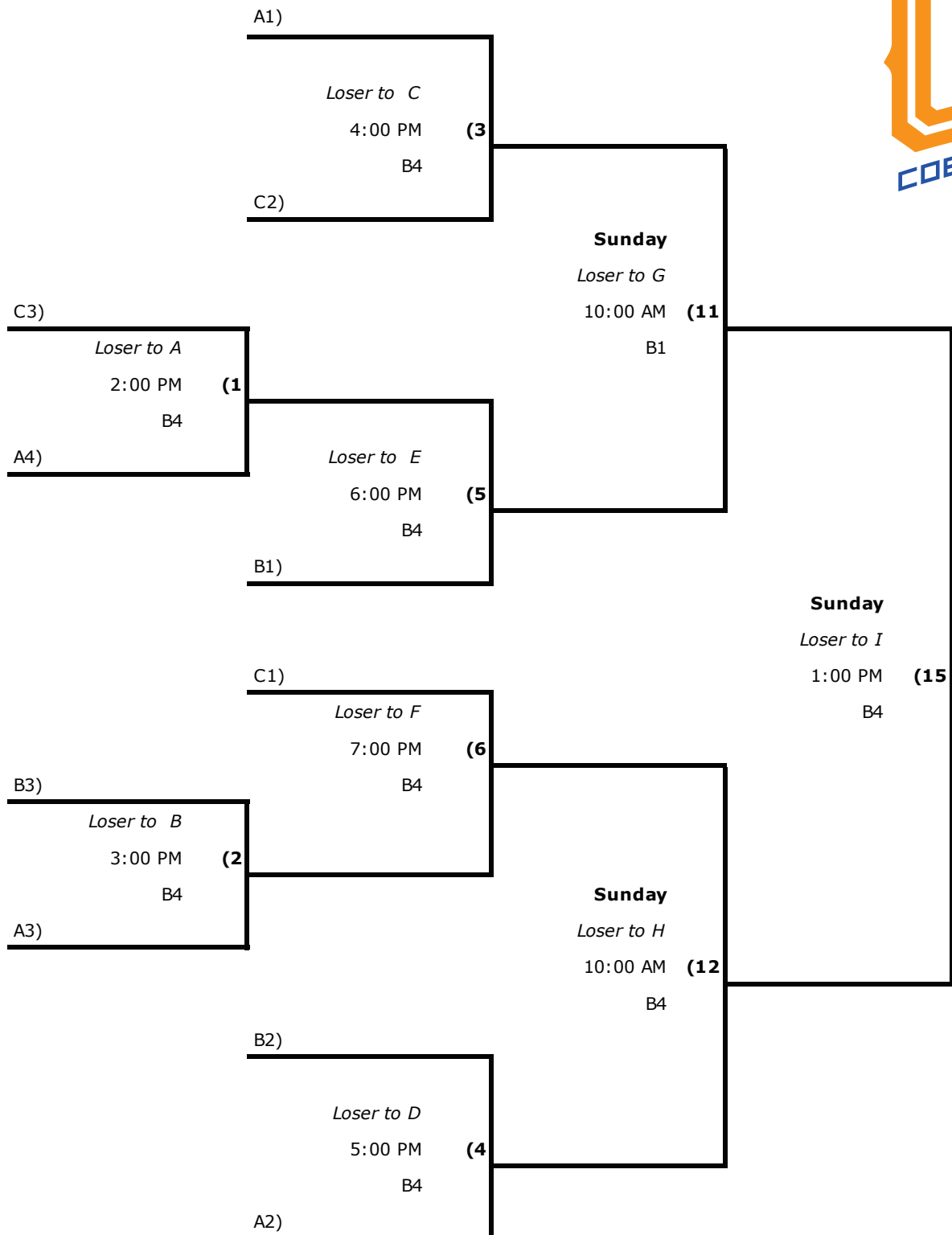

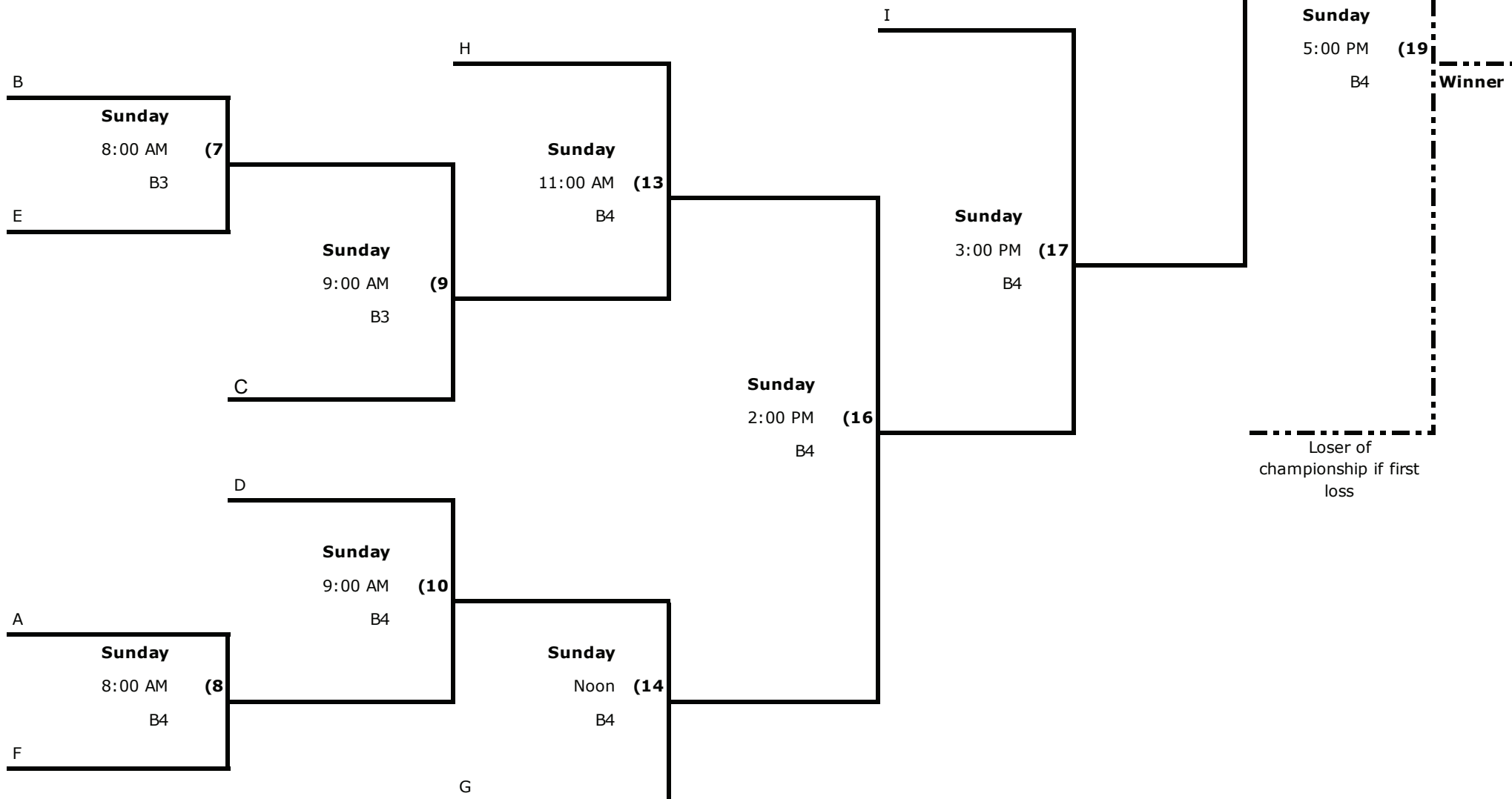

Open: **Open Comp teams** may designate a player to be **"UNRESTRICTED"** this player's HR's do NOT count against the team's totals. Walk them and they get a triple and if it's a guy and there are two outs the woman can take 2nd. Don't have to touch 1st or 2nd.
Format: 1-1 count like regular season

Other rules
 1. The 20 run rule is in effect after the third (3rd) inning, 15 run rule is in effect after the fourth (4th) inning, or 10 run rule is in effect after the fifth (5th) inning, in all games played.
 2. Teams must have 9 players for all tournament games.
 3. The uniform rule is not in effect but all players must have a number on their back.
 4. Batting orders are to be submitted to the Official Scorekeeper at least five (5) minutes before game time.
 5. Gametimes: 50 minutes, None in Championship and If game
 6. A coin toss before the game will determine the home team.
 7. Undefeated team is home in championship, flip in IF game
 8. The tie breaker rule WILL be used in this tournament. Each half inning after time has expired or after the 7th, will start with the last BATTER being placed at 2nd base.
 9. **Courtesy Runner rule:** Each team is allowed one courtesy runner per inning male & female. If used, courtesy runners will enter the game once the player

they will enter for has reached a base. Any rostered player may run, male for male, female for female, but should that players position come up to bat while they are on base they are out on base.
 10. Anchorage Sports and Alaska ASA rules apply except where stated within this profile.
 11. Protest Committee consists of the Tournament Director, an umpire, and a person provided by the Tourney Director.
 12. Each team will receive balls for the weekend.
 13. Infield practice is not allowed.
 14. No metal cleats are allowed
 15. Teams hitting home runs over the fence or foul balls out of the playing field must retrieve the balls and return them to the Home Plate Umpire or supply a ball.
 16. No entry fee refunds will be made, unless the entire tournament is rained out.
 17. In any eventuality not covered above, the decision of the Tournament Director will prevail.
