The concession stand has a variety of beer and wine for sale during the tournament.

- If a ball leaves the field of play have someone from your team track it down immediately or provide a suitable replacement ball. By returning all game balls to the field of play each team will avoid any unnecessary game delays.
- Have a good time in the camping and parking areas before, during, and after the games.....but please remember to pick up after yourselves and your guests.
- Those tournament participants that choose to camp, please treat this as a privilege and be sure to clean up your camp site area. This includes ensuring all garbage, pallets, nails and burn piles are cleaned up. MSSA has placed trash cans along the outfield fence and a dumpster in the parking lot for disposal of trash. CAMPING IS ONLY PERMITTED IN THE SOFTBALL COMPLEX AREA. DAYTIME PARKING IS AVAILABLE IN THE LOT ACROSS THE STREET.
- FIRES ARE ONLY PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED FIRE PITS. We request that fire pits not to be used as trash receptacles and trash be put in its proper place.
- Please do not hit balls into fences for warm-up or batting practice.
